
Want the Podcast?

Delegate Nancy D. shared feedback on Chosen Agenda Item 16 from the World Service Conference: regarding support of newcomers affected by someone's drug addiction, who may or may not have been affected by alcoholism.

Al-Anon welcomes newcomers – helping them know this is *their* recovery. Alcoholism is a disease of addiction. We can get better together by redirecting *our* addiction to the addict or alcoholic; helping each other stay focused on the Al-Anon message .While we are inclusive, it's important to stay true to the Steps, Traditions and Concepts. Newcomers whose loved ones have other addictions are encouraged to attend. Looking back in our family history, many of us find that alcoholism was there, and the ISMs bleed through the generations. We can also direct newcomers to other resources that may assist them. What they use is up to them.
