Or if you hold your business meeting monthly, perhaps you could break the topic down into smaller chunks like this:

welcome newcomers, healthy group, good directions to meeting, literature for purchase, phone lists, sponsorship discussions, group inventory, group service, participation

Facing our Biases

Bias is partiality or prejudice, unfair preference for or dislike of someone. Are my own personal biases

keeping me from embracing those different from myself and being open and welcoming to all?

At the May Assembly, our Delegate brought back a discussion activity and skit from the World Service Conference (WSC) called Celebrating Our Differences and Common Purposes: Facing Our Biases. - Where do I usually sit in my home group? How do I feel if someone is in "my" spot?
- How often do I get out of my comfort zone and talk to someone before or after a meeting?
- Do I believe I can learn and grow by listening to someone much older or younger share?
